

Every year, the Grove City Chamber collects donations from our members to fund a Business Community Scholarship. Scholarships are awarded to one or more recipients within the Grove

City Area School District who are graduating from either Grove City Area School District, Grove City Christian Academy, or a Home Education Program. Applicants must be planning to major in a business related field.

Together, our business community is able to award one or more scholarships to help local students as they begin a new path. It also helps our community to encourage our youth to follow their dreams and perhaps return to Grove City after their schooling is completed. All contributing businesses are acknowledged at the scholarship presentations. The number of scholarships awarded and the amount of each depends on the total amount of donations collected. Every dollar collected is distributed in scholarships.



In addition, attendees heard from the Grove City Area Historical Society and Museum's Becky Sopher who detailed the mural project from the idea of doing a mural which originated from Roger Flynn, the hard work and dedication of the high school artists over a two year period to design and create the mural, the efforts of volunteers from the Grove City Area Historical Society & Museum and the community to assist with installation, and to the support shown from GCHS Art faculty Chris Bauer and Amanda DiAlesandro. Chris Bauer also spoke about the mural process, talked more about the Community Arts Program at Grove City High School, and introduced all four students (pictured below) who helped with the mural.
